Guidelines and Application for Binkley Foundation Grants and Scholarships

PURPOSE:To offer individuals from historically marginalized communities an opportunity to attend/participate in/create programs for personal growth in academics, career advancement, or cultural awareness.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Financial need
- 2. From a historically marginalized community
- 3. No particular age requirement
- 4. Plan to attend/participate in/create a qualifying program/event
- 5. Not be a Foundation director, officer, or employee, or a related person to such

SELECTION CRITERIA

- 1. Financial need
- Be able to articulate a goal and the plan to reach it (oral and short essay).
- 3. Recommendations
- 4. Complete an in-person (preferred) or online interview.
- 5. Report cards, performance reviews, previous experience
- 6. Extracurriculars, interests
- 7. Unusual personal or family circumstances
- 8. San Francisco Bay Area youth given priority

SELECTION PROCESS

- 1. Application is by invitation only.
- 2. Applications are due no later than the date three months prior to the need for assistance.
- 3. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information on the Grant/Scholarship Application Form. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 4. All information received from the applicant will be treated as confidential and will not be shared outside of the Foundation.
- 5. Applicants will be notified of the decision by the date the school or organization needs to know if the candidate will attend/participate.

AWARD AMOUNTS

The number and amounts of individual awards will vary from year to year. It is anticipated that 2-12 awards will be given out annually and that the dollar amount will range from \$500 to \$10,000. Scholarships will be granted on an annual basis and will be renewable based upon need and successful completion (passing) of the program attended or a positive reception (majority approval) of the event/creation.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The preference will be to make out checks to the school/program/organization. If that is not possible, the check will be made out to the recipient or to the recipient's legal guardian. The recipient is required to submit a copy of bills/fees to the Foundation prior to payment.

TAX TREATMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship recipients are responsible for determining their own tax obligations.
